## **Central Region 4-H Clover Collection**

Eligibility, Rules and Classes

## Eligibility:

- 1. Participants must be in grades 4 12 to participate.
- 2. Participants must be currently enrolled in 4-H.
- 3. Each participant may enter one garment class and one accessory class
- 4. There may be **two entries per county in class.**

## **Rules:**

- 1. The complete outfit excluding accessories must have been sewn by the contestant, except for Classes 1 and 2. In this Class, the top may be store bought.
- 2. Participants should refer to the Clover Collection Class Descriptions for clarification.
- 3. Appropriate construction methods should be used for member's age and skill level.
- 4. Judging will be on a grade-level basis with consideration given to these factors:
  a) appearance of model 20 points, b) outfit on model 40 points, c) construction as it affects appearance 30 points, d) knowledge of subject matter 10 points.
- 5. Judging will be completed prior to the modeling on stage.
- 6. Awards will be given for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and participation in each Class.
- 7. Pre-registration and two copies of the personal data sheet are required.
