

Volunteer Leader Position Description

Position Title:

- 4-H Junior Camp Adult Volunteer Leader

Purpose of Position:

- Provide leadership and mentorship to 4-H youth and help ensure a positive camping experience.

Responsibilities:

- Chaperoning, meal service, ensuring safety/protection of campers, assisting extension agents and camp staff, assisting with camp activities.

Time Commitment:

- A minimum of 6 hours of training prior to 4-H Camp dates.

Qualifications:

- Familiarity with and commitment to the mission of the University Of Tennessee Institute Of Agriculture and the 4-H Program.
- Experience working with youth.
- Experience with 4-H Camps and/or other youth camps (Preferred).
- Realize and believe in the importance of youth development and the need to provide youth with positive learning experiences.
- Possess a flexible personality and a willingness to learn.

Requirements:

- MUST complete the Adult Volunteer Application Form (F 809-A), the Background Disclosure Form (F 809-B), and the Background Screen Consent Form (F809-C). Also, must read and sign the Mandatory Reporting of Child Abuse Form. All applications must be approved by the UT Extension-Marshall County Office.
- Complete 4-H Junior Camp Training Session(s).
- Must adhere to 4-H Policies and Procedures.
- Must have health coverage/insurance.

Appointment Length:

- Approval date through June 11, 2021; renewable upon agreement by the volunteer and Marshall County 4-H Agent(s).

UT Extension-Marshall County agrees to:

- Provide the volunteer with 4-H Junior Camp training.
- Provide leader liability coverage for registered volunteers. Health coverage/insurance is NOT provided.
- Provide appropriate resources in order to encourage a positive camp experience for volunteer leader.

Benefits of Attending 4-H Junior Camp:

- Opportunity to positively impact the lives of youth.
- Develop new friendships and experiences.
- Spend a week at one of Tennessee's finest 4-H facilities.

Salary:

- No salary-Volunteer.
